1. Delhi's Narela industrial area's plastic factory catches fire-

- On Monday evening a fire broke out in a plastic factory in Delhi's Narela industrial area.
- 15 firefighters were rushed to the spot, the fire department said.
- Officials said that all the 10 workers working in the plastic factory when the fire broke out have managed to come out uninjured.

2. SCO-RATS meet, to focus on the situation in Afghanistan, hosted by India-

- The chairmanship of the Council of Regional Anti-Terrorist Structure of SCO(RATS SCO) was assumed by India on October 28 for a period of one year.
- On Monday a meeting was held in New Delhi comprising the counter-terrorism experts from India, Pakistan, and other member states of the Shanghai Cooperation Organization (SCO) to discuss how to boost cooperation in combating various regional security challenges.
- One of the major topics of discussion in the meeting was to be on the situation in Afghanistan, on how to deal with the threat from the terrorist groups active in the Taliban-ruled country.

3. Only fit pilgrims to embark on Char Dham Yatra, says Uttarakhand CM-

1. Rs. 59 lakh penalty imposed on KEB Hana Bank by the RBI-

- The Korean Bank, KEB Hana Bank, has been imposed a penalty of Rs. 59 lakh by the RBI for non-compliance with certain norms related to interest rates on deposits.
- On the basis of the "Reserve Bank of India (Interest Rates on Deposits) Direction, 2016", the Korean bank has been penalized for non-compliance.
