National News

- 1) Gujarat CM Bhupendra Patel launches 17th 'Shala Praveshotsav'

International Current Affairs

- 1. After Germany, India becomes the 4th largest vehicle market-

- Anurag Thakur, the Information and Broadcasting, and Sports and Youth Affairs Minister, has announced the initiatives that will help promote India as an International film shooting destination.
- The Minister when giving his speech at the inauguration of the star-studded Indian Pavilion at the Marche du Cannes on Wednesday in the French Riviera said that up to Rs. 50 Lakh will be granted to film units that employ 15% or more manpower from India.
